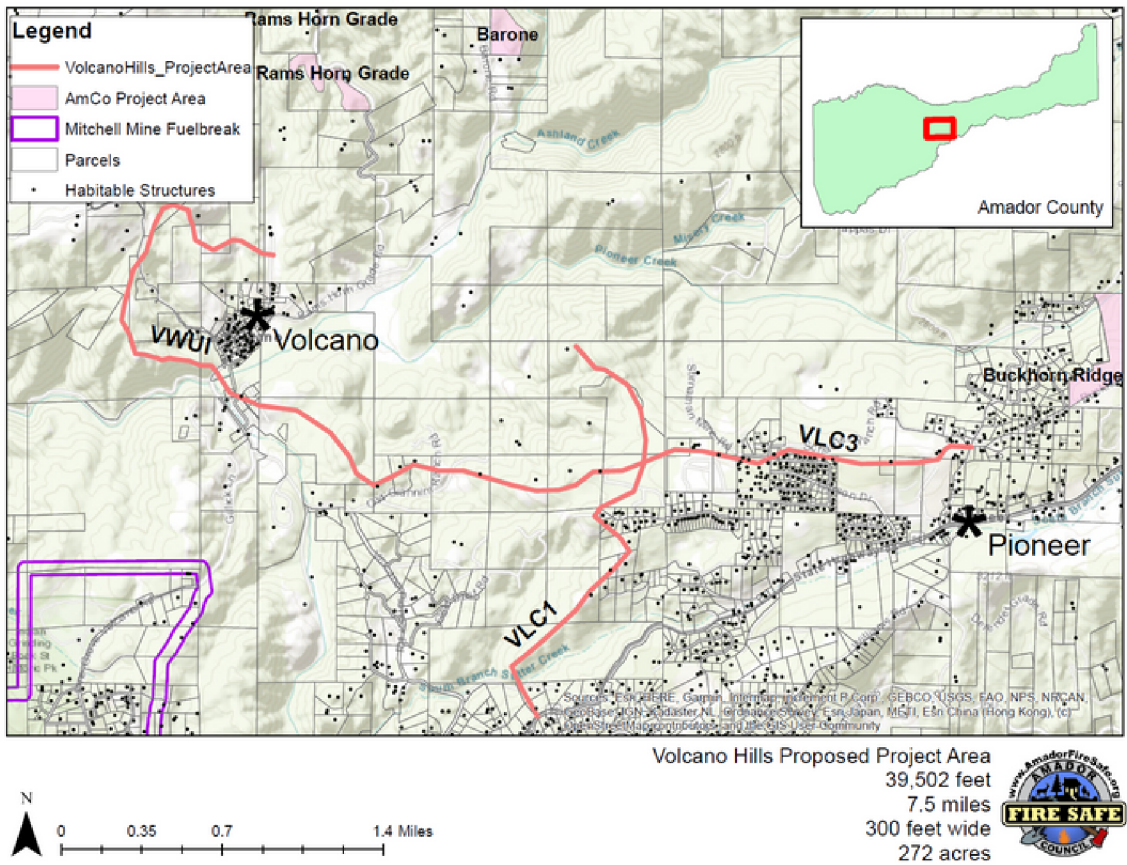


Volcano Hill Proposed Project Area - Community Fuelbreak

We're in the design and planning stage! The AFSC has funding for the initial design of the fuel break but we need additional funding to implement the environmental compliance work and implementation. The AFSC will be submitting a grant to the CalFire Fire Prevention funding opportunity in hopes of securing funding to complete this project. The grant will be submitted in March 2023.

**VOLCANO HILLS  
 COMMUNITY FUEL BREAK**

The Amador Fire Safe Council (AFSC) is partnering with the several (FWC) to develop and implement the Volcano Hills Community Fuel Break. The fuel break is designed to protect several communities in the event of a fire through the development of a shaded fuel break.

**TREATMENT**

- Project area would be 300-400 ft wide
- Removal of brush and small trees (up to 14" dbh for hardwood species and up to 12" dbh for conifer species) and pruning of ladder fuels at least 10' from ground level.
- The target of a max 30-foot by 30-foot spacing of trees.
- Work will be accomplished by combining mastication and handwork.
